SPACE IS LIMITED! Send in this Registration Form in order to be assured a seat! The Conference will begin at 7:00 pm on Friday, May 21, in the main arena of the Joyce Center on the campus of Notre Dame (across the road from the football stadium) and end at 2:30 pm on Sunday, May 23. Parking is FREE. On-site registrations begin at 5:00 pm on Friday at Gate 8 of the Joyce Center, and on Saturday and Sunday at 7:15 am. The Conference Bookstore, located in the concourse area of the Joyce Center, will open each day at the same time as on-site registrations. **We are not able to reduce the registration fees for those unable to attend all conference days or sessions.** Priests, please bring your own alb and stole. All priests will have lunches brought to them while they hear confessions during the lunch hours on both Saturday and Sunday. **All registration refund requests must be postmarked by May 7.**

BOX LUNCHES: Box lunches on Saturday and Sunday (\$12.40 for each day) will be available at the Joyce Center. Box lunches must be reserved on the registration form below, and **must be ordered by Wednesday, May 12.** Please do not lose your box lunch tickets. If you wish, you may also purchase a Notre Dame meal plan (see *NOTRE DAME HOUSING & MEAL PLAN, page 5*). There are also a number of sites on campus and near campus for the purchase of individual meals.

SPECIAL NEEDS SEATING: **The floor of the arena is reserved for those with special needs and one escort.** Special tickets will be required for this area. If you have a special need (i.e., attending in your own wheelchair, etc.), please indicate this on the registration form below. Two wheelchairs are available at Gate 10 for short-term use only.

BOOKSTORE VENDORS: The bookstore is operated by Queen of Peace Ministries as a service to those attending the conference, and sale by individual vendors on site is not permitted. FLAVOR OF MEDJUGORJE

Visionary Ivanka Elez and her husband Rajko, Marinko and Dragica Ivankovic, and Pat and Nancy Latta. Their talks along with other inspiring testimonies, beautiful music and liturgies will help rekindle the fire of the Holy Spirit in your soul on this Pentecost weekend.

Conference Speakers Include:



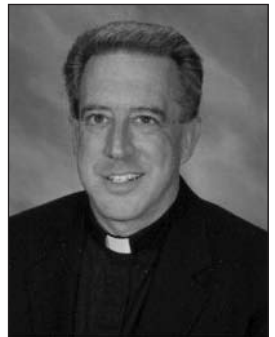
Ivanka Elez was the first to see Our Lady on the side of Mt. Podbrdo when the events of Medjugorje started on June 24, 1981. Her words, "Look Mirjana, Gospa!", have echoed throughout the world for the last 29 years. She has received all ten secrets revealed by Our Lady and no longer has a daily apparition, but she does see Our Lady once a year on June 25th. Her special mission is to pray for families. Ivanka and her husband Rajko have three children and live in Medjugorje.

Dana is one of Ireland's most successful entertainers and has received acclaim through best-selling Catholic recordings, top rated TV appearances, and conferences throughout the world. She joined young Catholics in singing when Pope John Paul II visited Denver for World Youth Day. Dana wrote the theme song "We Are One Body" for this event. She was the first woman to receive the prestigious San Benedetto award for her outstanding work in defending life and the family.



Marinko and Dragica Ivankovic have been close to the visionaries from the first days. At great risk to his own family, Marinko protected the children from the communist police who were chasing them. One journalist wrote, "Outside of the six visionaries, Marinko is the single most important witness to the amazing events of Medjugorje." Dragica was the first to inform Fr. Jozo of Our Lady's appearance to the six children.

Fr. Charlie Becker is a priest in the Archdiocese of Chicago. He has made over 50 trips to Medjugorje and has helped establish numerous Marian prayer groups in the Chicago area. He is a popular speaker and preacher at conferences and retreats throughout the country and has been a guest homilist on EWTN. He is also co-national coordinator of the Marian Movement of Priests in the United States.



Traci Mathew was raised with a solid foundation in the Catholic faith but later all but turned her back on it. A trip to Medjugorje with her family played a key part in reclaiming her faith. Traci has dedicated her life now to serving the Church and the call of Our Lady. She is a popular and inspiring speaker and author of a new book titled "A Survivor of the Lost Generation of Catholics." She is a stay at home mom and lives with her husband and three children in the Chicago area.

Pat and Nancy Latta received the great grace of conversion through the messages of Our Lady of Medjugorje. Patrick was a successful businessman and Nancy a commercial lawyer when they left everything behind and moved to Medjugorje in 1993. Now, after 17 years of living in Medjugorje and 12 years of construction, they have established the Our Lady of the Sacred Heart Retreat House, which is dedicated to fostering vocations to the priesthood and religious life.

NOTRE DAME HOUSING & MEAL PLAN

ON-CAMPUS HOUSING AT NOTRE DAME

The University of Notre Dame is offering dormitory housing and a special meal plan during the Medjugorje Conference. Housing will be in the University's dormitories. **Dorms will be available starting at 3:00 pm on Friday, May 21 with checkout at 11:00 am on Sunday, May 23. There is no provision for rooms on Sunday, May 23.** Blankets, sheets, and towels are provided during your stay. Lavatories and showers are shared in common with separate men's and women's facilities on each floor. There is no provision for more than two people per room. Requests for adjoining rooms cannot be guaranteed, but will be honored if possible. Every effort will be made to provide clean and comfortable rooms. *On-campus room reservations must be made by Monday, May 17 using the form below.*

ON-CAMPUS MEAL PLAN

Meals will be provided starting with dinner on Friday, May 21 and concluding with lunch on Sunday, May 23. **This service can be purchased as a complete package. It must be purchased by Monday, May 17 using the form below.** No arrangements are necessary for the purchase of individual meals. The food service option will be served in a dining hall on campus near the dorms, about a 10 -15 minute walk from the Joyce Center. (There are a number of sites on campus and near campus for the purchase of individual meals.)

PROCEDURE FOR RESERVING ON-CAMPUS HOUSING AND/OR MEAL PLAN

University policy requires that both food and housing be paid for in advance using **US funds only**. *Cancellation will be accepted if requested in writing prior to Monday, May 17.* A \$10 cancellation fee will be charged. **NOTE:** Meal plan and housing may be treated as separate items. Registering for one does not require registering for the other.

Confirmation will be sent to you along with your room assignment and further information regarding your stay on campus. **Confirmations will not be sent out before April 23.** For additional information about on-campus housing or meal plans, call (574) 631-6691 or write to the address below. 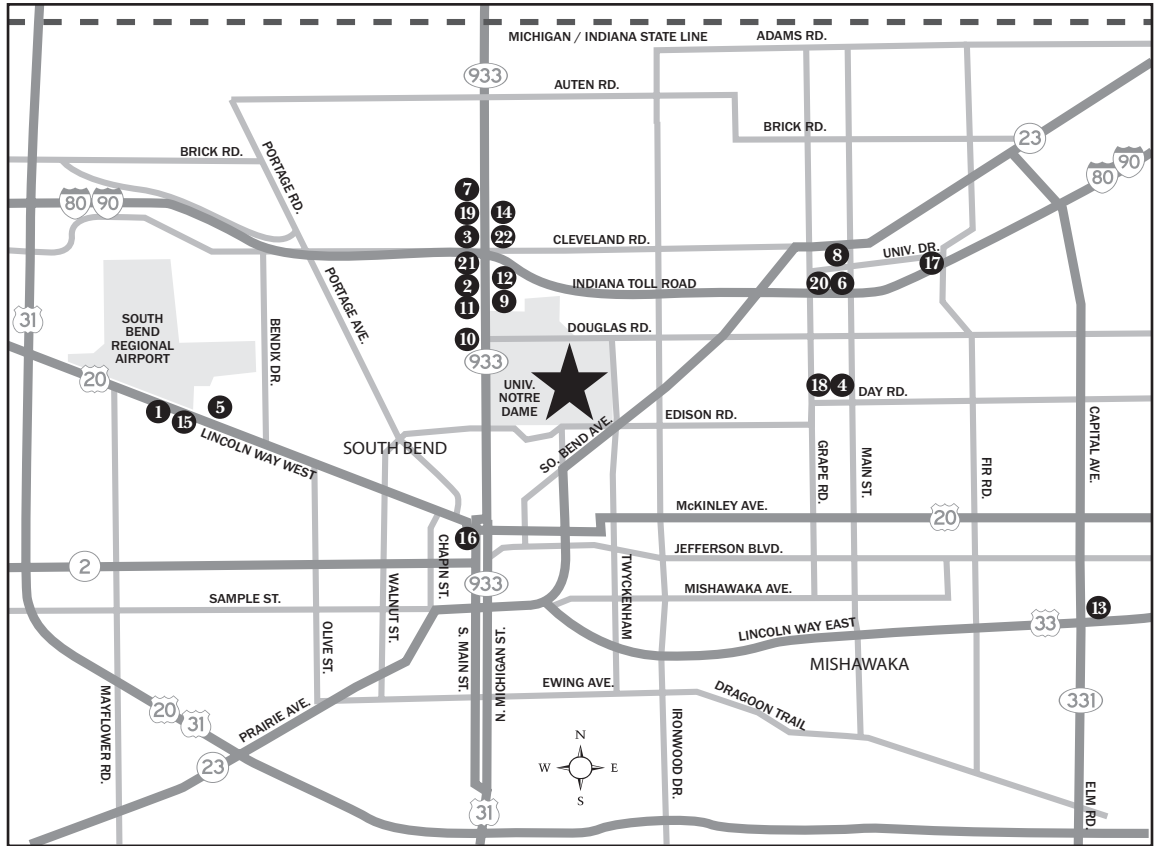
